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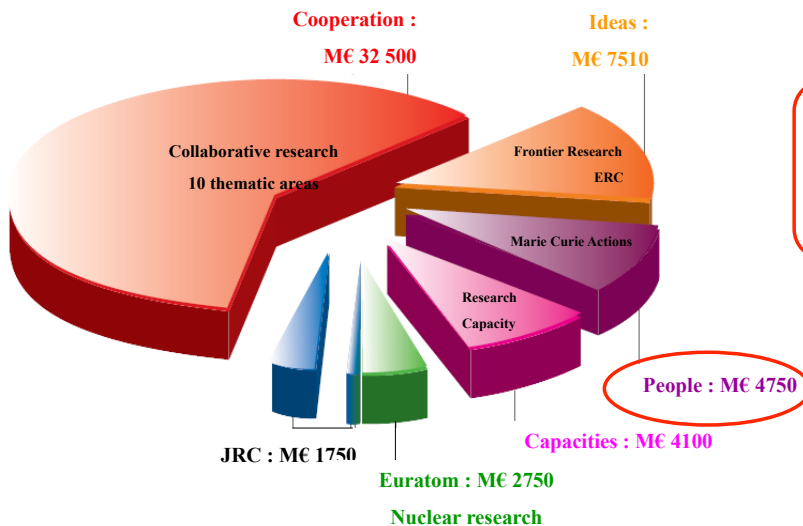
FP7 overview (2007-2013)

EU's main instrument for funding research

Aim : Contribute to the Union becoming the world's leading research area

Total EC budget : M€ 50 500

People programme = Marie Curie Actions

From pure mobility actions to a dedicated programme for structuring training, mobility and career development

One main condition to be eligible: **Mobility**

Geographical

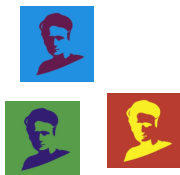
Sectorial

- Employment contracts with full social rights
- Adequate working conditions and attractive salaries
- Addressed to researchers at all stages of their careers
- Peer-reviewed international evaluation
- European (and international) prestige



Marie Curie Actions

Main characteristics



- Open to all domains of research (bottom-up approach)
- Application through calls for proposals
- Open to experienced researchers: must at the time of *deadline for submission* have a PhD (or equivalent four years research experience)
- Mobility requirement: must not have spent more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the *deadline for submission* at the host. org.





Intra-European Fellowships for career development (IEF)

To support the career development of experienced researchers at different stages of their careers

- 12 to 24 months (full-time) period
- Any nationals working/living in MS/AS moving to another MS/AS
- Mobility requirement at the deadline of the call (definition)

International Outgoing Fellowships for career development (IOF)

To reinforce the international dimension of the career of European researchers

- 12-24 months period in a TC plus 12 months of compulsory return phase in MS/AC
- For Nationals of MS/AC

MS= member state
AC= ass. country
TC= third country

International Incoming Fellowships (IIF)

To reinforce the scientific excellence of MS/AS with incoming to Europe top-class researchers from TC

- 12-24 months period in MS/AC
- Any nationality and mobility from TC to MS/AC
- Possible return phase to country of origin (12 months)

Upload Proposal File

For the proposal content (Part B) you must use exclusively PDF ("Portable Document Format", compatible with Adobe Acrobat Reader version 5 or higher, with embedded fonts). It is recommended not to upload very big files. To keep sizes down avoid colour and unnecessary high resolution pictures and graphs. The average size of a research proposal is 2MB (less for mobility actions). You should aim to restrict your proposal to under 3MB, and under no circumstances try to upload a file larger than 10MB

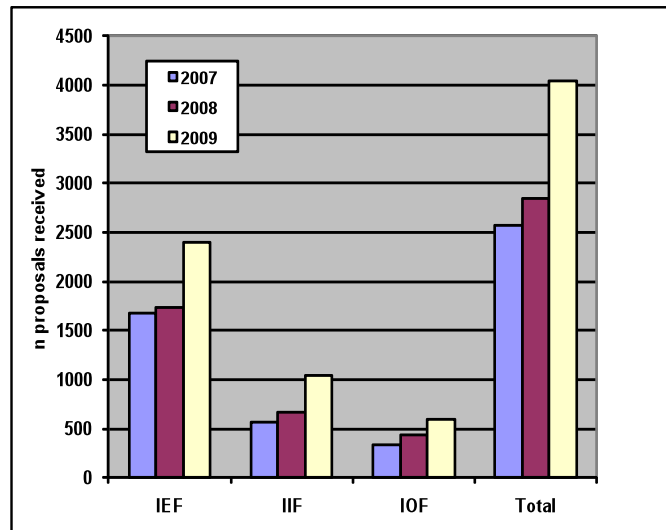
